Hands On Athens Mission

The mission of Hands on Athens is to create a coalition of organizations dedicated to assisting low-income Athens-Clarke County homeowners in historic neighborhoods to maintain, repair, and restore their properties as part of overall neighborhood revitalization.

What is Hands On Athens?

Hands On Athens is a sub-committee of the Athens-Clarke Heritage Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) private, non-profit organization. Now in its tenth year, HOA plans to assist 12-16 low-income homeowners in three historic neighborhoods. The focus areas for Hands On Athens 2009 are the historic Hancock Corridor Neighborhood, the East Athens Neighborhood, and New Town. Exterior renovations and repairs will take place on the project weekend, such as:

- ◆ painting
- ◆ siding and roof repair
- ◆ gutter installation
- ◆ door and window repair and replacement
- ◆ porch repair
- ◆ landscaping
