

STATUE RECOGNIZING BEN T. EPPS, Georgia's First Aviator



The Athens-Clarke County mayor and commission has approved placing a statue of Ben T. Epps, downtown near city hall and across from 120 E. Washington St., the location of the shop where Mr. Epps built the first airplane in Georgia.
